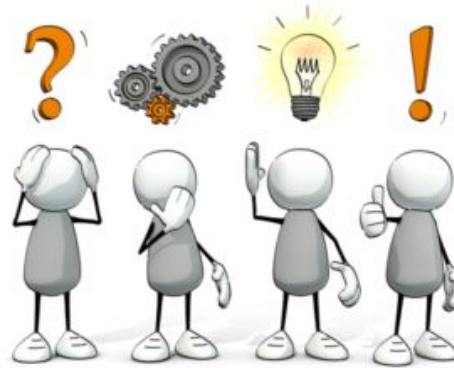
Vocabulary

Interchangeably: in a way that can be exchanged without making any difference or without being noticed

Blame: to say or think that someone or something did something wrong or is responsible for something bad happening

Hit: to move your hand or an object onto the surface of something so that it touches it, usually with force.

Introduction



Query is another word for question. The words "query" and "question" can be used **interchangeably**. For example, if you need additional information from someone, you might say, "I have a query for you. A type of query, which many people perform several times a day, is a search query. Each time you **hit** the enter key to search for something using a search engine, you perform a search query. A query is an outcome of uncertainties that people have about a given subject. The response that an individual obtains for a query generally comes from an authority or a reliable source.
