Vocabulary

Antler - each of the branched horns on the head of an adult deer (typically a male one), which are made of bone and are grown and cast annually.

Feline - a cat or other member of the cat family.

Poaching - illegal hunting or catching (game or fish) on land that is not one's own or in contravention of official protection.

Pitcher plant - a plant with a deep pitcher-shaped pouch that contains fluid into which insects are attracted and trapped. The plant then absorbs nutrients from their bodies.

Coniferous - (of a plant) bearing cones and needle-like or scale-like leaves that are typically evergreen.

Span - an arch or part of a bridge between piers or supports.

Quarry - a place, typically a large, deep pit, from which stone or other materials are or have been extracted.

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
