Cellular: (in this context) relating to a phone system that sends signals by radio instead of by a wire.

Stream: (in this context) to listen to or watch sound or video on a computer directly from the internet rather than downloading it and saving it first.

Analogue: a system in which information, such as sound or images, is stored or sent in a continuously changing form, such as electrical signals, radio waves, or film.

To Shell Out: to pay money for something, especially when the cost is unexpected and not wanted.

Glitch: a small problem or fault that prevents something from being successful or working as well as it should.
