# Vocabulary

**D-day:** the day on which an important operation is to begin or a change to take effect.

**Collateral:** additional but subordinate; secondary.

**Ramifications:** a complex or unwelcome consequence of an action or event.

**Myriad:** countless or extremely great in number.

**Ideology:** a system of ideas and ideals, especially one which forms the basis of economic or political theory and policy.

**Rubble:** waste or rough fragments of stone, brick, concrete, etc., especially as the debris from the demolition of buildings.

**Biometric:** relating to or involving the application of statistical analysis to biological data.
