Vocabulary

Historical: concerning history or past events.

Weapons: something designed to cause harm or damage.

Jewels: a precious stone cut into a shape to be used as jewellery (necklaces, chains, earrings, rings, etc.)

Display: put (something) in a such a place so that it can be easily seen.

Fossil: the remains of a plant or animal in a rock, that is preserved over the years.

Preserved: to maintain something in its original state or form.

Conservation: the action of conserving something.

Skeleton: the frame of bones supporting a human or animal body.
