Adverbs of degree tell us the intensity, attentiveness, or even depth of a particular action.

- 1. They answer the question "how much" or "upto what extent"
- 2. Adverbs of degree usually modify verbs, adjectives, adverbs or clauses.
- 3. Adverbs of degree are usually placed before the adjective, adverb, or verb that they modify (Though there are some exceptions).

Some common examples of Adverb of Degree are listed below
