



- An article is a word used to modify a noun, which is a person, place, object, or idea.
- Articles function as adjectives.
- They are considered as Demonstrative Adjectives.
- `A', `An' and `The' are known as Articles.
- `A' and `An' are known as Indefinite Articles whereas `The' is known as Definite Articles.



Uses of the Indefinite Article 'A':

\star Before a word beginning with a consonant to denote one number. Examples:

- 1. a cat
- 2. a table
- 3. a book
- 4. a note

\star Before a word starting with a vowel having a consonantal sound to it. <u>Examples:</u>

- 1. a unit
- 2. a European
- 3. a useful article
- 4. a university
