
Articles

An <u>article</u> is a word that comes before a noun.











 Use "a" when the next word begins with a consonant sound.

Examples: a flower a tasty apple

 Use "an" when the next word begins with a vowel sound.

Examples:

an unusual flower

an apple

"The" is used to refer to specific or particular nouns.

The man whom you met yesterday is my uncle.

The lady you saw at the theatre is my wife.

The bungalow you like is already sold.
