Vocabulary

Temptation: the desire to do something, especially something wrong or unwise.

Grant: (in this context) a sum of money given by a government or other organization for a particular purpose.

Infallibility: the quality of being infallible; the inability to be wrong.

Perpetrator: a person who carries out a harmful, illegal, or immoral act.

Intentional: done on purpose; deliberate.

Characterisation: a description of the distinctive nature or features of someone or something.

Allegation: a claim or assertion that someone has done something illegal or wrong, typically one made without proof.
