A brief introduction of bengaluru

Bengaluru is the capital city of the Indian state of Karnataka. It has a population of over 10 million, making it a megacity and the third most populous city and fifth most populous urban **agglomeration** in India.

Bangalore is often referred to as the "**Silicon Valley of India**" because of its role as the nation's leading information technology (IT) exporter. E.g : Indian technological organisations ISRO, Infosys, Wipro and HAL are headquartered in the city. It is home to many educational and research institutions in India, such as Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Indian Institute of Management (Bangalore) (IIMB) etc.
