Vocabulary

Puncture: a small hole in something.

Illusion: an instance of a wrong or misinterpreted perception of a sensory experience.

Starfish: a marine invertebrate with five or more radiating arms.

Aficionados: a person who is very knowledgeable and enthusiastic about an activity, subject, or pastime.

Glitter: (in this context) tiny pieces of sparkling material used for decoration.

Cartilage: firm, flexible connective tissue found in various forms in the larynx and respiratory tract, in structures such as the external ear, and in the articulating surfaces of joints.

Scalpel: a knife with a small, sharp, sometimes detachable blade, as used by a surgeon.
