Vocabulary

Resident populations: all people who usually live in a place at any time.

Media: every broadcasting and narrowcasting medium such as newspapers, magazines, TV, radio, billboards, direct mail, telephone, fax, and internet.

Sector: an area or portion that is distinct from others.

Abundance: a very large quantity of something.

Mining: the process or business of digging in mines to obtain minerals, metals, jewels, etc.

Hub: the effective centre of an activity, region, or network.

Port: a town by the sea or by a river that has a harbour, or the harbour itself.
