Bookkeeper: someone whose job is keeping an exact record of the money that has been spent or received by a business or other organization.

Balance sheet: a statement that shows the value of a company's asset (things of positive value) and its debts.

Net worth: the value of the assets (property and money) that a person or business has, after any debts are taken away.

Complacent: feeling so satisfied with your own abilities or situation that you feel you do not need to try any harder.

Persistence: to continue to exist past the usual time, or to continue to do something in a determined way even when facing difficulties or opposition.

Garner: to get or earn something valuable or respected, often with difficulty.
