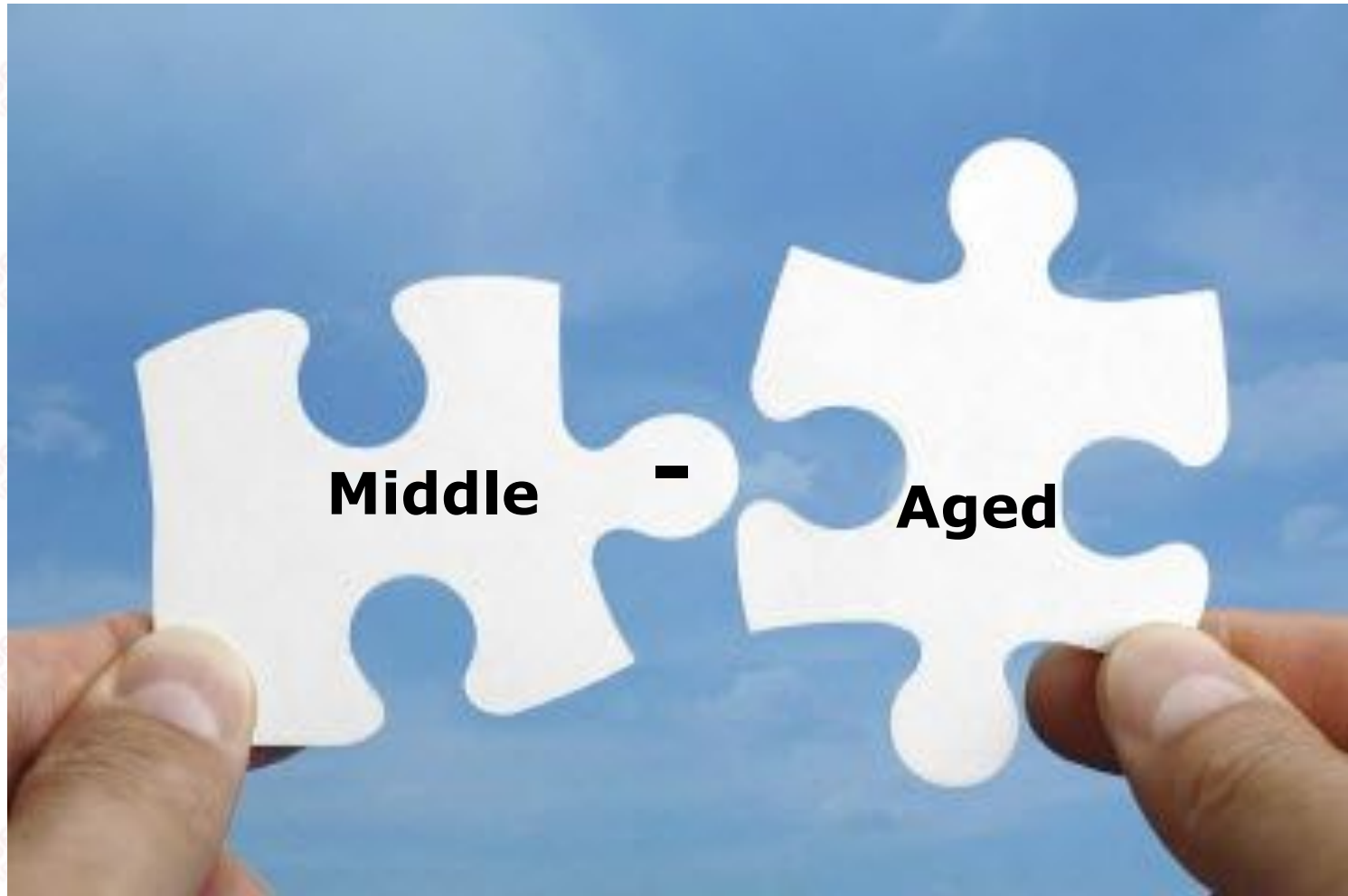

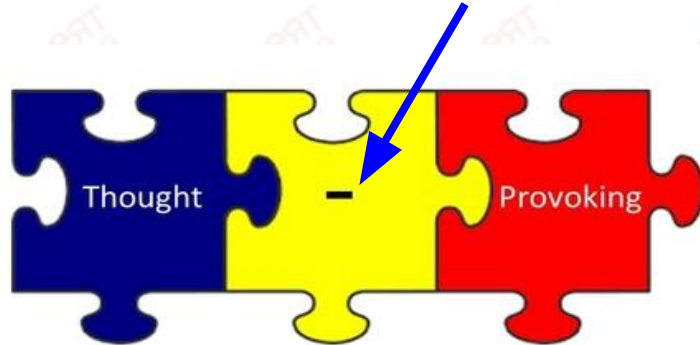


Introduction

What are compound adjectives?

Have you ever come across words with hyphens?

A Hyphen



black-furred dog



These are called Compound Adjectives - meaning, an adjective that has two or more words, comes before the noun in a sentence and represents just one idea. (2 hyphenated words are used to represent one idea)

For example:

1. She has a **black-furred** dog.
2. They have a **two-month** old son.

Let us look at some **compound adjectives** and some examples.

Examples of Compound Adjectives

- Daniella is a **part-time** worker.
- Beware of the **green-eyed** monster.
- I love this **brightly-lit** room!
- Danny's dog is **well-behaved**.
