


Introduction

What are compound adjectives?

Have you ever come across words with hyphens?



For example:

- 1. She has a **black-furred** dog.
- They have a two-month old son.



black-furred dog

These are called Compound Adjectives - meaning, an adjective that has two or more words, comes before the noun in a sentence and represents just one idea. (2 hyphenated words are used to represent one idea)

Let us look at some compound adjectives and some examples.

Examples of Compound Adjectives

- Daniella is a part-time worker.
- Beware of the green-eyed monster.
- I love this brightly-lit room!
- Danny's dog is well-behaved.
