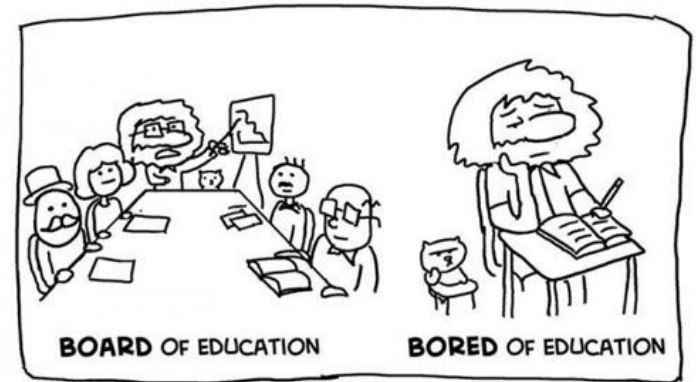

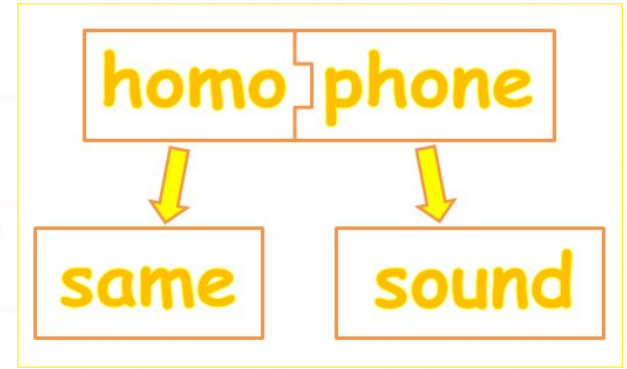


Homophones
