

Vocabulary

Watchdog: monitor (a person, activity, or situation).

Accreditation: official approval, especially in order to maintain satisfactory standards.

Dissemination: the act of spreading something, especially information, widely; circulation.

Disease mongering: efforts by a pharmaceutical company to create or exaggerate a malady for the purpose of increasing sales of a medication.
Solicit: to ask someone for money, information, or help.
Tout: attempt to sell (something), typically by a direct or persistent approach.
Rampant: (of something bad) getting worse quickly and in an uncontrolled way.
Counterfeit: copied exactly in order to make someone believe that the copy is the original.
