# Vocabulary

**Watchdog:** monitor (a person, activity, or situation).

**Accreditation:** official approval, especially in order to maintain satisfactory standards.

**Dissemination:** the act of spreading something, especially information, widely; circulation.

**Disease mongering:** efforts by a pharmaceutical company to create or exaggerate a malady for the purpose of increasing sales of a medication.

**Solicit:** to ask someone for money, information, or help.

**Tout:** attempt to sell (something), typically by a direct or persistent approach.

**Rampant:** (of something bad) getting worse quickly and in an uncontrolled way.

**Counterfeit:** copied exactly in order to make someone believe that the copy is the original.
