Gizmo: a gadget, especially one whose name the speaker does not know or cannot recall.

Heart failure: a chronic condition in which the heart doesn't pump blood as well as it should.

Mortality: the state of being subject to death

Glaucoma: A condition of increased pressure within the eyeball, causing gradual loss of sight.

Ocular: Of or connected with the eyes or vision.

Epilepsy: A neurological disorder marked by sudden recurrent episodes of sensory disturbance, loss of consciousness, or convulsions, associated with abnormal electrical activity in the brain.

Subdermal: below the skin.

Semiconductors: A semiconductor is a substance used in electronics whose ability to conduct electricity increases with greater heat.
