
Dock Management



Vocabulary

Demurrage: money that must be paid when a chartered (= rented) ship is used for longer than agreed, or when goods are collected later than the agreed time after being taken off a chartered ship.

Correlated: If two or more facts, numbers, etc. correlate or are correlated, there is a relationship between them.

In essence: the basic or most important idea or quality of something.

Detention: the act of officially detaining someone.

Rigid: stiff or fixed; not able to be bent or moved.

Introduction

What is dock management?

Dock management systems are designed to eliminate common and costly logistics problems, they use real-time and physical data to help facilities efficiently manage their operations.

These systems combine loading dock equipment with intelligent software to monitor, communicate, and manage loading dock status, thus helping companies evade costs related to **detention** charges, product spoilage, and employee accidents.
