Vocabulary

Dumping: exporting goods at prices lower than the home-market prices.

Backlogs: an accumulation of something, especially uncompleted work or matters that need to be dealt with.

Censure: the formal expression of severe disapproval.

Sporadic: occurring at irregular intervals or only in a few places; scattered or isolated.

Unforeseen: not anticipated or predicted.

Persistent: continuing to exist or endure over a prolonged period.

Predatory: seeking to exploit or oppress others.
