Vocabulary

Juncture: a stage in a process or activity.

Treatise: a written work dealing formally and systematically with a subject.

Embryonic: starting to develop.

Tyranny: cruel and oppressive government or rule.

Oligarchy: a form of government in which all power is vested in a few persons or in a dominant class or clique; government by the few.

Coercion: use of force or intimidation to obtain compliance.

Premise: an idea or theory on which a statement or action is based.

Forgoing: to abstain or refrain from; do without.

Implicit: suggested though not directly expressed.
