The Plot



Nineteen militants who were associated with the Islamic extremist group “Al-Qaeda” hijacked four aircrafts and were instrumental in carrying out coordinated suicide attacks against several targets in the United States of America.

Two of the airplanes were flown into the twin towers of the World Trade Center in New York City, a third plane hit the Pentagon just outside Washington, D.C., and the fourth plane crashed in a field in Pennsylvania.

An estimated 3,000 people were massacred during the 9/11 terrorist attacks.
