2. **Pageantry:** Elaborate display or ceremony.
3. **Show Off:** To behave in a way that is intended to attract people's attention and make them admire you.
4. **Three-ring circus:** A circus with simultaneous performances in three rings.
5. **Spring up:** To appear or develop quickly and/or suddenly.
6. **Big Top:** The main tent in a circus.
7. **Mummer:** An actor in a traditional masked mime or a play.
8. **Feat:** An action or a piece of work that needs skill, strength or courage.
