Vocabulary

Equivalence (n): having the same amount, value, purpose, qualities, etc. (adj. Equivalent).

Life Science: one of the types of science that deal with the structure and behaviour of living things, such as botany, zoology, biochemistry, and anthropology.

Black Holes: a region in space where gravity is so strong that nothing, not even light, can escape.

Pioneer: a person who is one of the first people to do something.

Vaccine: a substance containing a virus or bacterium in a form that is not harmful, given to a person or animal to prevent them from getting the disease that the virus or bacterium causes.
