Future Continuous Tense



Future Continuous Tense

It is used to express a continued or an ongoing action in future.

The future continuous tense is a verb tense that indicates that something will occur in the future and continue for an expected length of time. It is important to note that the future continuous tense is only used with action words because it is only possible to do them for a duration.

Examples: She will be cooking tonight.

The above example conveys the ongoing nature of an action , which will occur in the future.

Examples:

```
I will be reading .
```

```
sentence formation: Subject + will be + 1st form of verb ( read ) + ing + object
```

I will be going out tomorrow.

$$(will + be + go + ing)$$
