Bureaucrats: Bureaucrats are officials who work in a large administrative system

Someone's take on something: someone's attitude or opinion about a situation

Premiums: an amount of money paid at regular times to insure (= protect against risk) your health or life, or your home or possessions.

Patent: the legal right to be the only one who can make, use, or sell an invention for a particular number of years.

Inflate:to increase the value or price of something, or to become more valuable or expensive.
