

How to communicate an Annual Stock Report



Vocabulary

Prospects: the possibility or likelihood of some future event occurring.

Cash flow: the total amount of money being transferred into and out of a business, especially as affecting liquidity.

Dividends: a sum of money paid regularly (typically annually) by a company to its shareholders out of its profits (or reserves).

Disseminate: spread (something, especially information) widely.

Opine: hold and state as one's opinion.

Soothe: gently calm (a person or their feelings).

Introduction

Annual reports are formal financial statements that are published yearly and sent to company stockholders and various other interested parties. The reports assess the year's operations and discuss the companies' view of the upcoming year and the companies' place and **prospects**.
