VOCABULARY

Relevance: important to the matter at hand, to know why it matters or how it is important.

Convey: to carry, bring, or take from one place to another; transport; bear.

Semblance: the outward appearance or apparent form of something, especially when the reality is different, approximation.

Fragmentary: consisting of small disconnected or incomplete parts, incomplete, broken.

Embody: be an expression of or give a tangible or visible form to (an idea, quality, or feeling), express, include.

Symbiotic Relationship: a symbiotic relationship benefits both parties. For example: The two of you have a symbiotic relationship: she fixes your car and you style her hair.
