Introduction

- An **interrogative sentence** is a sentence whose grammatical form indicates that it is a question.
- Interrogative sentences can serve as yes – no questions or as *wh*-questions, the latter being formed using an interrogative word such as *who*, *which*, *where* or *how* to specify the information required.
- Questions are also frequently marked by intonation, in particular a rising intonation pattern.
