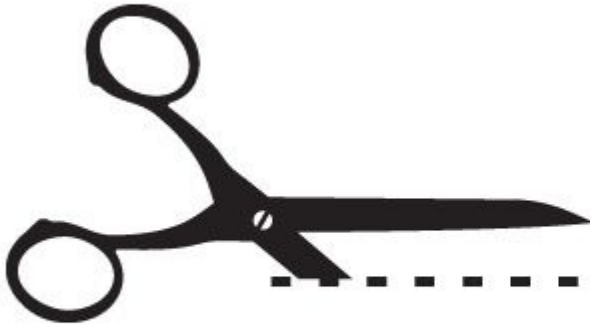

Introduction

Most English verbs take **-ed** for the *past tense* or *past participle*. However many verbs do not follow this rule.

Irregular Verbs form their past tense and past participle tense in an unpredictable manner.

Examples of irregular verbs:

- awake–awoke–awoken
- deal–dealt–dealt
- beat–beat–beat
- begin–began–begun
- bite–bit–bitten
- bleed–bled–bled
- blow–blew–blown

Irregular Verbs: Examples

Base Form	Past Simple	Past Participle
arise	arose	arisen
bear	bore	born(e)
choose	chose	chosen
do	did	done
eat	ate	eaten
fall	fell	fallen
go	went	gone
have	had	had

Base Form	Past Simple	Past Participle
know	knew	known
lead	led	led
make	made	made
pay	paid	paid
ride	rode	ridden
see	saw	seen
take	took	taken
wear	wore	worn
