Vocabulary

Digital Journalism: also known as online journalism is a contemporary form of journalism where editorial content is distributed via the Internet as opposed to publishing via print or broadcast. What constitutes 'digital journalism' is debated by scholars.

Go-To: used to describe the best person to deal with a particular problem or do a particular thing, or the best place to get a particular thing or service.

Multiplicity: a large number or wide range (of something).

Seek: to try to find or get something, especially something that is not a physical object. (past simple: sought)

Denigrate: to say that someone or something is not good or important
