Introduction

Job hunting, job seeking, or job searching is the act of looking for employment, due to unemployment or discontent with a current position.

Job hunting can also **stem from** a deep need for change or sentiments of **stagnation** in a present job position.

The immediate goal of job seeking is usually to obtain a job interview with an employer which may lead to getting hired. The job hunter or seeker typically first looks for job **vacancies** or employment opportunities.
