# Vocabulary

**Embark on (phrasal verb):** to start something new or important.

**Mend fences:** to try to become friends again with someone who you have argued with.

**Motorcade:** a series of cars and other motor vehicles that moves slowly along a road carrying someone important, especially during an official ceremony.

**Kerb:** a raised edge along the side of a street, often forming part of a path for people to walk on.

**Pivotal:** vitally important.

**Aftermath:** the period that follows an unpleasant event or accident, and the effects that it causes.
