What Are Modals?

Modals (also called **modal verbs**, **modal auxiliary verbs**, **modal auxiliaries**) are special verbs which behave irregularly in English. Many modal verbs have more than one meaning.

We have learnt about modals of possibility.

Today, we will learn about modals of obligation and necessity.

Obligation- The state of being forced to do something because it is your duty, or because of a law, etc.

Necessity- The fact that something must happen or be done; the need for something.
