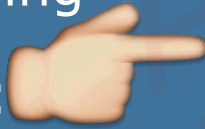

Vocabulary

Miniscule: extremely small; tiny.

Nanoscale: on a scale of 10^{-9} metre; having or involving dimensions of less than 100 nanometres.

Squeak through (something): (idiom) to manage just to squeeze through an opening.

Precise: very accurate and exact.

Pasty: pale and unhealthy in appearance.

Ubiquitous: seeming to be seen everywhere.

Conventional: used and accepted by most people : usual or traditional.

Crude: very simple and basic in a way that is true but not complete.

Foresight: the ability to see what will or might happen in the future.
