VOCABULARY

Fold: bend (something flexible and relatively flat) over on itself so that one part of it covers another.

Symbol: a sign, number, letter, etc. that has a fixed meaning.

Carving: an object or a pattern made by cutting away material from wood or stone.

Clay: thick, heavy soil that is soft when wet, and hard when dry or baked, used for making bricks and containers.

Stems: the main long thin part of a plant above the ground from which the leaves or flowers grow.



stem
