Vocabulary

Classifieds: small advertisements placed in a newspaper and organised in categories.

Unbundling: The process of breaking apart something into smaller parts. One example would be taking a bundled computer system and unbundling it into its individual pieces such as the monitor, keyboard, and mouse, and then selling each of these items individually.

Episodic: (of a television or radio program or magazine story) broadcast or published as a series of installments.
