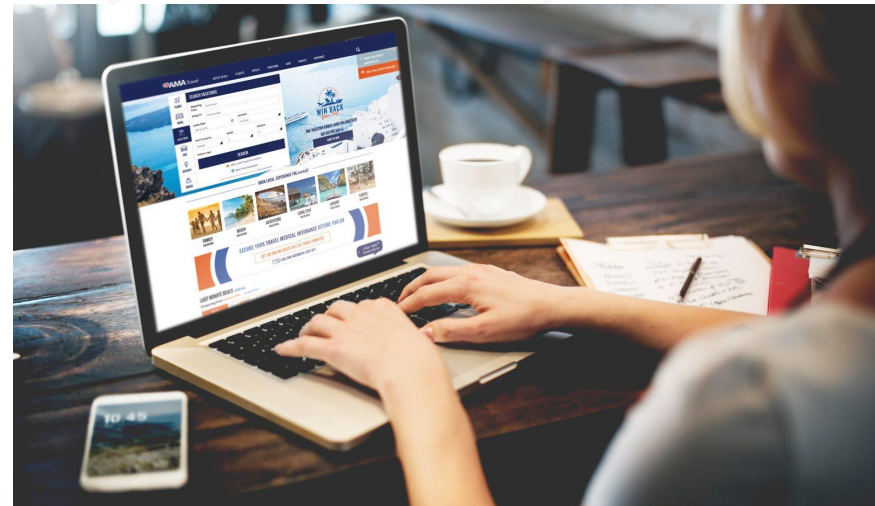
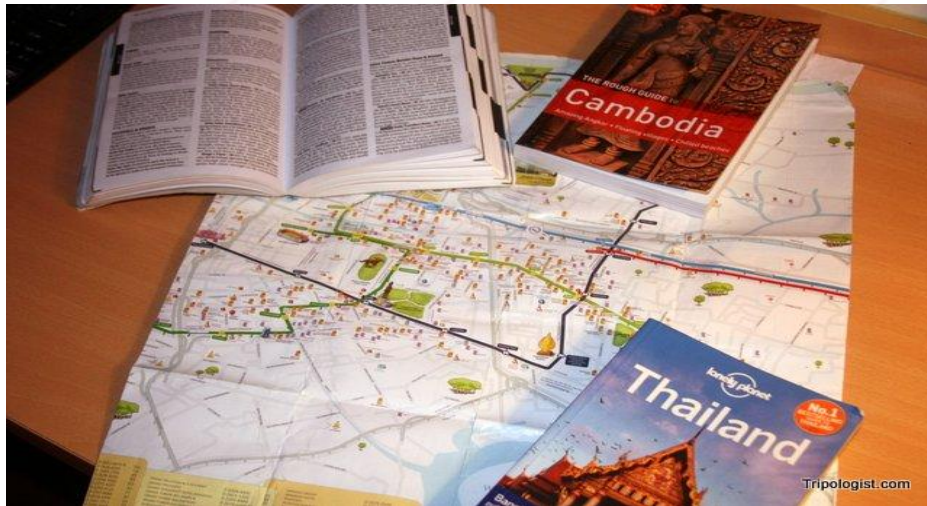


Planning A Trip
