Vocabulary

Valuable (adj.): (in this context) important, useful or beneficial.

Script: the written text of a play, film, or broadcast.

Execute: put (a plan, order, or course of action) into effect.

Appropriate: suitable or proper in the circumstances.

Permission: the action of officially allowing someone to do a particular thing; consent or authorization.

Professional: relating to or belonging to a profession.

Budget: an estimate of income and expenditure for a set period of time.

Compose: write or create (a work of art, especially music or poetry).

Release: the action of making a film, recording, or other product available to the public.
