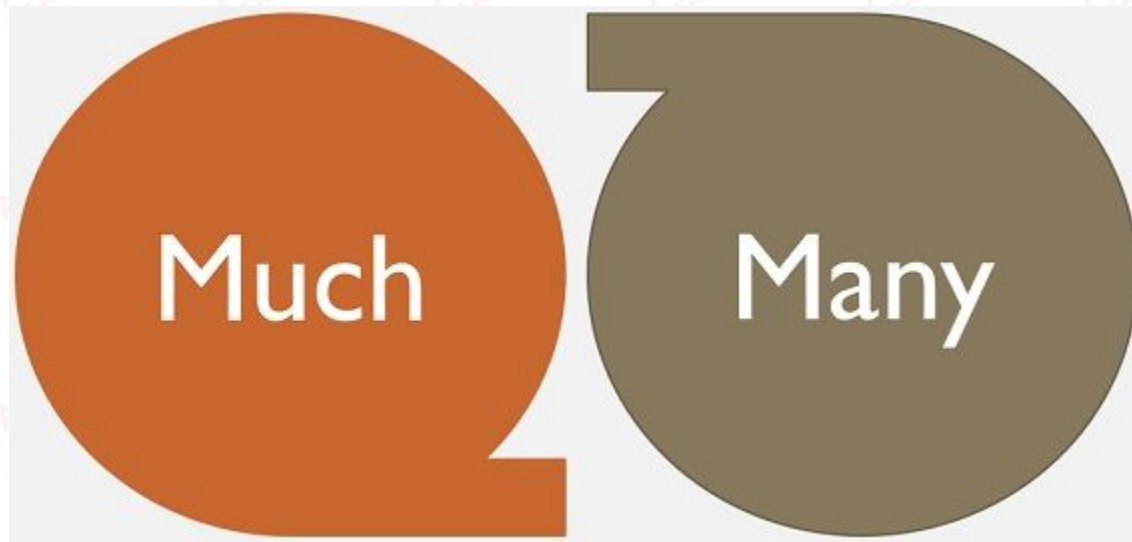


Quantifiers



Introduction

Much and many are quantifiers which are used to indicate the amount or quantity of a countable or uncountable noun.



The use of much and many

- **Much** is used with **singular nouns**

There isn't **much food** in the fridge.

(NOT There isn't many food in the fridge.)

You have given me too **much cheese**.

- **Many** is used with **plural nouns**.

Were there **many people** at the meeting?

(NOT Were there much people at the meeting?)

How **many shrimp** did you catch?
