What is a question tag?

Question tags are short questions that are used at the end of statements.

They are used to confirm that something is true or not, or to encourage a reply from the person we are speaking to.

How are question tags formed?

Question tag are formed by using the auxiliary or modal verb from the statement and the appropriate subject.



Some common Modal Auxiliary verbs to be used for question tags:

Can: Mia can take her family to the airport.

Could: She **could** have helped me.

Must: She **must** listen to her mother.

Should: She **should** have reached home by now.

Will: He will take us to the fair.
