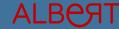

Vocabulary

Quirky: characterised by peculiar or unexpected traits. For example: Jenny and Kyle have planned some quirky designs for their new home.

Perch: to sit on or near the edge of something. For example: The robin is perched on our fence. OR All of us were perched on barstools because all the tables were occupied!

Render: cause to be or become; make. For example: Heavy snowfall rendered our journey home impossible!

Contraption: a machine or device that appears strange or unnecessarily complicated, and often badly made or unsafe. For example: We wondered how the contraption worked?
