

Role Play on Exchange of Phone Numbers



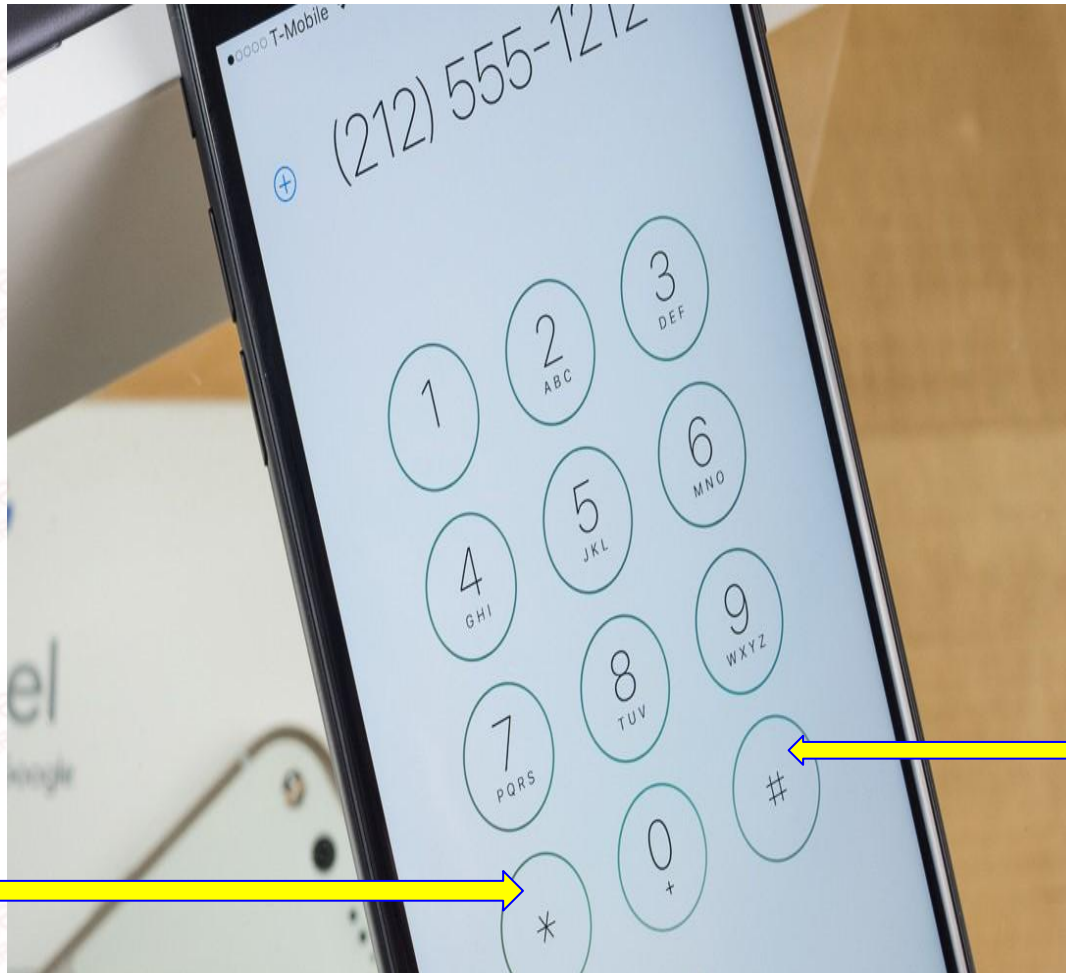
Names of the Numbers

Usually, there are 10 to 12 **digits** in a mobile phone number:
XX-XXX-XXX-XX-XX



From left to right: **oh** (used when reciting a string of numbers, e.g. when giving a phone number; in other situations this number is called *zero*), **one**, **two**, **three**, **four**, **five**, **six**, **seven**, **eight**, **nine**.
