VOCABULARY

Intimidating: Frightening (someone), especially in order to make them do what one wants. For example: He has an intimidating personality.

Hostile: Showing or feeling opposition or dislike; unfriendly. For example: We had to move because the neighbourhood started turning hostile after local gang numbers grew.

Stalking: To pursue or approach stealthily. For example: The lioness was stalking her prey before she found a way to pounce!
