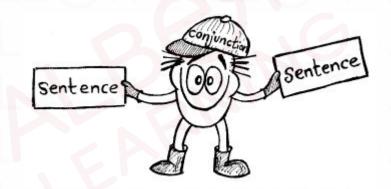

Conjunctions

We use words called conjunctions to join two parts of sentences.



For example:

I am hungry. I am thirsty. = I am hungry **and** thirsty.

I left work early. I felt sick. = I left work early **because** I felt sick.
