Vocabulary

Snub: rebuff, ignore, or spurn disdainfully.

Provoke: deliberately make (someone) annoyed or angry.

Elicit: evoke or draw out (a reaction, answer, or fact) from someone.

Stalk: pursue or approach stealthily.

Bully: (here) use superior strength or influence to intimidate (someone), typically to force them to do something.

Embarrassment: a feeling of self-consciousness, shame, or awkwardness.

Harassment: aggressive pressure or intimidation.

Perpetrator: a person who carries out a harmful, illegal, or immoral act.
