VOCABULARY

Twitch: Short sudden jerking or convulsive movement which is unintentional or involuntary. E.g. The old man had a twitch in one eye (noun).

Index Finger: Finger next to the thumb. E.g. We point with our index finger.

Peripheral: Things that are just outside our main focus.
E.g. We use peripheral vision to see things which are not directly in front of us.

Powdered: Crushed fine like grains of sand.
E.g. Powdered spices last longer than whole spices.

Plaque: An ornamental tablet made of wood, clay or metal made in honour of a person or event.
E.g. Metal plaques usually mark houses where famous artists were born.
