VOCABULARY

Gramophone: old-fashioned term for record player.

Prominent: important; famous.

Simultaneously: at the same time.

Prone: likely or liable to suffer from, do, or experience something unpleasant or regrettable.

Engrave: to cut words, pictures, or patterns into the surface of metal, stone, etc.

Broadcast: transmit (a programme or some information) by radio or television. (in this context).

Opera: a dramatic work in one or more acts, set to music for singers and instrumentalists.

Boycott: refuse to cooperate with or participate in (a policy or event).

Conductor: a person who directs the performance of an orchestra or choir.
