Vocabulary

Prefecture: a district under the government of a prefect.

Metropolitan: relating to a large city.

Eclectic: deriving ideas, style, or taste from a broad and diverse range of sources.

Wards: a district into which a city, town, or other area is divided for administration, election of representatives, etc.

Sprawl: a large area of land covered with buildings.

Upswing: an increase in strength or quantity; an upward trend.

Speculation: the forming of a theory or conjecture without firm evidence.

Leveled out: to stop rising or falling and stays at the same level.

Kimonos: a long, loose robe with wide sleeves and tied with a sash, originally worn as a formal garment in Japan and now also used elsewhere as a robe.
